Results

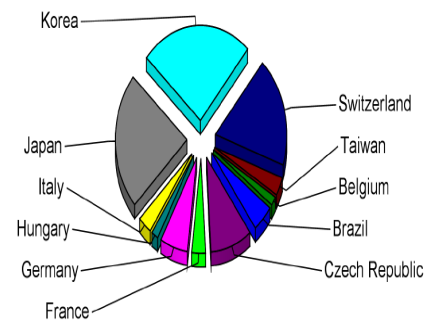
